POLLUTEC PARIS First speakers announced, Launch of the Young Talent Awards, and Opening of the ticketing

Pollutec's new Paris event 26-27 November 2024

In addition to France and Europe's premier show for environmentally-friendly solutions for industry, cities and regions - organised in Lyon by RX France - now there is a new biennial event for the key environmental and climate sector in all its breadth, to be held in Paris Expo, Porte de Versailles, Hall 1, 26-27 November.



For over 45 years Pollutec has been recognised as the premier show for innovative environmental solutions for industry and climate, towns & cities, and regions. Every 2 years the show in Lyon attracts tens of thousands of professionals (in 2023 51,000 participants and 2,000 exhibitors of whom 200 were start-ups).

To complement this already-iconic event, the Pollutec team have designed a new biennial event, to be held in Paris.

The climate emergency and tightening regulations, coupled with the resulting innovations emerging from industry, demand a more regular opportunity for the ecosystem of ecological transition actors to connect.

This Paris edition is driven by simple geography - it's closer to regions like Western, Northern and Eastern France and Northern Europe, and of course closer to Brussels, home to Europe's Green Deal.

As in Lyon the show takes a **systemic approach**, with all 11 of **Pollutec's major traditional sectors** represented - an approach driven by the environmental challenges confronting both public and private actors.

This year's event will focus on 4 main themes, which are reflected in the Pollutec Paris 2024 programme:

- **Regulation -** what to understand, what to retain, and how to adapt
- Financing for ecological transformation in businesses
- **Resource -** circular economy, recycling, use, AI etc.
- Employment & training the right training and skills

A workshop area and an **Employment & Training** area will complete the main stage, while **the main stage** will see many leading environmental names from France and Europe coming to discuss and propose solutions to the environmental challenges.

Pollutec is delighted to announce the **first speakers** invited to take the stand in the show's conference areas.



- **Brune Poirson**, Sustainable Development Director at **Accor** will be discussing the importance of **regulation** in the transformation of design and use.
- Sylvain Waserman, President of Ademe and Paloma Aba Garrote, Director of Cinea will be jointly addressing the topics of regulation and financing to discuss the Green Deal 5 years after its roll-out across Europe.
- Marie Ekeland, Founder and CEO of the 2050 fund will be explaining the role of finance in supporting high-impact projects and businesses.
- Elin Bergman, Co-Founder of the NORDIC CIRCULAR HOTSPOT, will be speaking on the topic of **Resource** and more particularly on the circular economy.

- Pierre-Emmanuel Martin, CEO of CARBON will address employment and training against the vast backdrop of France's re-industrialisation and needs.



"We decided in Lyon in 2023 to open up a new space for the sector to meet and discuss issues, with the biennial Pollutec Paris complementing the existing Pollutec to help and support actors facing impact, accelerated climate change new regulations, and so on. This new location also allows us to reach out to Europe and all its regulatory challenges, a central pillar of Pollutec Paris 2024" declares Anne-Manuèle Hébert, Director of Pollutec. "It's through this systemic alignment with the sector part of Pollutec's traditional DNA - that we and our ecosystem can collaborate every year to coconstruct global action strategies, whether in Paris or Lvon."

To celebrate this new Paris concept Pollutec is also organising a new competition: the **Young Talent Awards**. Complementing the Pollutec Innovation Awards organised in Lyon - which rewards technological innovations that have strong market potential in the environment sector - this competition aims to showcase **10 innovative projects being incubated right now in Labs at Universities or Grandes Ecoles.** The 10 projects will be presented in a dedicated area beside the Employment & Training Area. Project leaders will come to the main stage on Wednesday 27 November to pitch in front of a jury of large companies and sector experts. The prize for the winner of the Young Talent Awards will be a start-up booth at Pollutec 2025 in Lyon.
